Please describe the overall aims and objectives of your organisation and the activities or services your organisation provides

Our initiative aims to foster sustainable living practices, promote food security, and strengthen social bonds within the community through the establishment and maintenance of community gardens. Our objectives include:

Providing access to fresh, locally grown produce for community members.

Educating individuals about gardening, sustainable agriculture, and environmental stewardship.

Creating inclusive spaces for people of all ages and backgrounds to connect, learn, and collaborate.

Enhancing green spaces within the community and promoting biodiversity.

What is the aim of your project?

We have a small piece of land at the community centre that we have been told we can use. The community gardens aim to increase access to fresh, nutritious produce, particularly in areas where there may be limited availability of affordable fruits and vegetables or a lack of knowledge on how to grow fruits and vegetables. Participants will get to eat the crops they grow and learn how to grow multiple types of fruit and veg. Our volunteers will share their knowledge and guide the growing process.

What Outputs will be delivered to achieve the aim?

The primary output of a community garden is the quantity and variety of fruits, vegetables, and crops grown within the garden.

Outputs also include educational materials such as growing how to guides. These materials help community members learn how to grow, harvest, and prepare nutritious food in their own homes.

What Outcomes will be delivered?

Increased access to fresh produce participants will take away crops they grow to cook. Additionally, participants will have greater knowledge and increased confidence to start to grow at home. They will know how to grow, what to grow when to harvest and be able to produce their fresh fruit and vegetables in the garden at the centre or their home gardens.

We will track the quantity and distribution of harvested produce, volunteer participation rates, and community outreach activities. Using tools like attendance records, harvest logs, and survey data to collect relevant information on increased knowledge from the start of the project to the end.
